Please be reminded that all these items must be filled-up before December 15, 2015.

Finally, kindly note that the attached deployment report should be strictly followed; hence no changes and realignments shall be made. The same report was forwarded to DBM Central Office to serve as their basis for the approval of the creation of the items as well the DBM ROs for the issuance of SARO/NCA and NOSCA.
