

In addition, kindly inform/coordinate with the requesting parties (as indicated in the Remarks column) regarding items given through their initiative.

To expedite the filling-up of these positions, the division offices may now commence the evaluation and selection process following the existing hiring guidelines of the Department while waiting for the issuance of NOSCAs by the DBM Regional Offices (ROs). Please be reminded that all these items must be filled-up before December 15, 2015.

Finally, kindly note that the attached deployment report should be strictly followed; hence no changes and realignments shall be made. The same report was forwarded to DBM Central Office to serve as their basis for the approval of the creation of the items as well the DBM ROs for the issuance of SARO/NCA and NOSCA.
